

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 7, TRAFFIC, SUBSECTION 7-32.1  
HANDICAPPED PARKING ON STREETS AND SUBSECTION 7-32.2,  
RESTRICTED PARKING ZONES, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES  
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Council of the Township of West Orange, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 7-32.1, Handicapped Parking on Streets, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township *of* West Orange is hereby supplemented and amended as follows (*italic type denotes deletion, bold type denotes addition*):

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking places. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted to park in these places.

<b>Valley Road</b>	<b>Southeast</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>Beginning 316 feet west of the westerly curbline of Dean Street extended, and extending 22 feet southwesterly.</b>

Section 2. Subsection 7-32.2, Restricted Parking Zones, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange is hereby supplemented and amended as follows (*italic type denotes deletion, bold type denotes addition*):

7-32.2 Restricted Parking Zones. Pursuant to N.J.S.A 39:4-197.6, Restricted Parking Zones, as defined in N.J.S.A. 39:4-207.6e, are established in front of the following residences as indicated on the Tax Maps of the Township of West Orange, at the specified locations. Parking within a specific zone is restricted to the motor vehicle issued a permit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.7. In accordance with N.J.S.A., 39:4-197.6 parking is permitted in the Restricted Parking Zone except when prohibited in front of the residence by other sections of this Chapter.

<b>205 Watchung Avenue</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>Beginning 143 feet south of the southerly curbline of Washington Street extended, and extending 20 feet south.</b>
<b>83 Lindsley Avenue</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>Beginning 256 feet east of the easterly curbline of Longview Street extended, and extending 20 feet east.</b>
<b>17 Dean Street</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>Beginning 259 feet south of the southerly curbline of Valley Road extended, and extending 20 feet south.</b>
<b>135 Main Street</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>Beginning 155 feet south of the southerly curbline of Charles Street extended, and extending 20 feet south.</b>
<b>72 Rollinson Street</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>On Nutman Place, beginning 35 feet east of the easterly curbline of Rollinson Street, and extending 20 feet east.</b>
<i>72 Rollinson Street</i>	<i>1</i>	<i>Beginning 35 feet south of the southerly curbline of Nutman Place extended, and extending 20 feet south.</i>
<i>75 Lindsley Avenue</i>	<i>1</i>	<i>Beginning 155 feet west of the westerly curbline of Brennan Drive and extending 20 feet westerly.</i>
<i>72 Mitchell Street</i>	<i>1</i>	<i>Beginning 323 feet from the easterly curbline of Rollinson Street, and extending 22 feet easterly.</i>

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof, under any circumstances, is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect any other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision(s) or application(s) and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

Section 3. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law and upon the approval of the New Jersey Department of Transportation if required.

### LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

This Ordinance is in response to requests from handicapped residents who reside at 131 Watson Avenue, 32 Edisonia Terrace, 205 Watchung Avenue, 83 Lindsley Avenue, 17 Dean Street, and 135 Main Street. 72 Rollinson Street has been corrected to conform with superseding parking regulations. A handicapped parking space has been added for the use of disabled customers of a medical supply business located at 480 Valley Road.

By adopting this Ordinance, the Township will establish a handicapped parking stall adjacent to each of these addresses. Such parking stalls are permissible under the laws of New Jersey, and they are designated as Restricted Parking Zones. Additionally, two handicapped space no longer used have been deleted from the list.
