Help New Jersey Department of Health learn about tick-related encounters

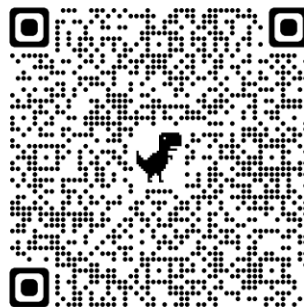
The New Jersey Department of Health's Communicable Disease Service (CDS) is using an online survey to better understand knowledge, attitudes, and prevention practices concerning tick-related encounters among outdoor public workers.
