A Tribute To The Memory of *William "Lefty" Boland*

The Legacy of Lefty

William "Lefty" Boland was the long time Director of the West Orange Recreation Department whose career spanned five decades beginning in the 1930's and continuing into the 1970's. Under his leadership, the Recreation Department flourished and developed into one of New Jersey's premier municipal recreation programs. Mr. Boland was particularly known for his genuine concern for West Orange families that faced tough day to day circumstances. He remains today a revered figure in West Orange history and a true credit to his family and his community.

William "Lefty" Boland Golf Tournament

The Annual "Lefty" Boland Golf Tournament was initiated in 1978 and has been a popular West Orange event ever since. The tournament began as an event for employees of the Town of West Orange. Through the years the tournament has expanded its reach to include a number of "non-employee" individuals from the community. The event has always been held at a country club in West Orange. Over the years the Tournament Golf Committee has made countless charitable contributions to worthwhile causes for the betterment of West Orange.

In 2011, the Tournament Committee selected Bill Kehoe as the new tournament director and they embarked on a re-energized vision for the tournament's future. The Committee added new members representing the Township's educational establishment. With the cooperation and guidance of the West Orange Board of Education's Student Support Services Department, the Boland Grants were established.

The Boland Grants

The world is experiencing an unprecedented technological explosion. Products thought to represent cutting edge technologies one year are considered obsolete two years later. This is particularly true in the field of education.

Boland Grants provide funds for the purchase of new technologies. Grants are limited to special education classes or programs within the West Orange Public Schools. Requests in the area of Assistive Technology are particularly encouraged. Applicants shall be required to electronically submit an application outlining but not limited to the following information:

- 1) A specific list of the requested technologies.
- 2) Students to be served by the new technology.
- 3) Anticipated enhancements to the class or program.
