Essex County residents and those who work or attend school in Essex County can get vaccinated at our sites. Appointments are not needed; just walk in. If you want to make an appointment, visit www.EssexCOVID.org or call 973-877-8456.

Available Vaccinations:

Moderna vaccines: People ages 18 and older are eligible to receive the Moderna vaccine. Moderna is given in two doses. When you receive your first dose, you will be given an appointment 28 days later to receive your second dose. It is important that you keep the second appointment.

J&J vaccines: People ages 18 and older are eligible to receive the J&J vaccine.

Pfizer vaccines: People ages 12 and older are eligible to receive the Pfizer vaccine. **Children ages 12 to 17 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.** Pfizer is given in two doses. When you receive your first dose, you will be given an appointment 21 days later to receive your second dose. It is important that you keep the second appointment.

There are no out-of-pocket costs to receive vaccines. Residents will be asked to provide their medical insurance information so Essex County bill the insurance company \$40 for each dose of the vaccine. If you do not have insurance, the cost of the vaccine will be covered by the Health Resources and Services Administration's Provider Relief Funds.
